

List of Water-Powered Mills in Clark County (in no particular order)

Donnelsville Sawmill – built in 1890; located on Rte. 40 between Milton-Carlisle Rd. and Tecumseh Rd. East of Donnelsville

Cottage Color and Paint Works – built in 1877; North side of Buck Creek west of Wittenberg, Cliff & Cedar Streets

Sawmill at mouth of Mill Run – built prior to 1855? Located North of W. North Street, East of Wittenberg.

McKee Mill – built in 1927; located 1 ½ miles N.E. of New Carlisle.

Redmond Mill – built in 1930; located at junction of Sinking Creek and Little Beaver Creek, 5 miles E. of Springfield in Springfield Twp.

Rubsam's Mill – demolished by 1922; located 2 miles west of Springfield

Andrew Seitz Mill – built in 1859; located in Tremont City

Steinberger Mill – located along Mad River

Storm's Grist Mill – located on Upper Valley Pike

Snyder's Mill – located on Upper Valley Pike at Shrine Road

Sawmill in Clifton, OH – located on East side of town
